At Paso Pacifico, we believe people will care for their forests and reefs when given the knowledge and tools.

We put this belief into practice by building a culture of conservation in Nicaragua. Our spider monkey patrols are led by five community rangers, farmers who are now talking to their neighbors about the value of wildlife in forests. Our parrot nest boxes are placed high into the forest canopy by the former parrot poachers who have become our greatest asset in parrot protection. Sea turtles are looked after by our team of eight community rangers who have acquired the skills to deploy satellite transmitters relied on by conservation scientists worldwide.
